Example Supply Checklist

April 15, 2010

Admin Supplies

- (1) Bullhorn w/batteries
- (2) Flip charts
- (15) Permanent markers
- (5) Notepads
- (1) Neighborhood roster (enlarged to poster size and laminated), non-permanent markers
- (1) Topo area evacuation map (enlarged and laminated)
- (12) Sharpie pens
- Pens/pencils

Field Supplies (pre-packed in to-go backpacks)

- (10) Clip boards with team instructions (Damage Assessment, Search and Rescue, etc.)
- (4) 4-lb Class A/B/C Fire extinguishers
- (3) Emergency blankets
- (3) Rolls duct tape, 60 yds
- (3) Rolls Caution tape, 1000 ft
- (6) Reflective vests
- (4) Pairs work gloves
- (4) Dust masks
- (6) Pairs safety goggles
- (36) Pairs non-latex gloves
- (3) Rope, nylon, 3/8", 100 ft
- (4) Cans spray/marker paint
- (12) Water pouch/packs
- (5) Crescent wrenches, 10" (for gas shut off, etc.)



Tools

- (1) Chain saw, 16"
- (2) Crow bars, 30"
- (1) Ax
- (1) Tree saw
- (1) Rubber mallet
- (1) Block and tackle/Come-along
- (2) Hydraulic house jacks and bracing/levering timbers

Lighting

- (1) C cell flashlight w/batteries
- (8) AA cell halogen flashlights
- (8) AA cell LED flashlights
- (2) Halogen 12v rechargeable spotlights
- (2) Propane 2-mantle gas lanterns + extra mantles
- (6) Propane bottles (16.4 oz)
- (24) Lightsticks
- (2) 100w halogen work lamps, extension cords
- (3) 36 pack batteries (AA, AAA, C, etc.)

Communications

- (1) Sunmate solar radio
- (2) ICOM IC-F21GM GMRS two-way radios
- (1) J-pole or similar GMRS antenna, 25' coax lead
- (8) FRS/GMRS two-way radios (Motorola, Midland, etc.)
- (100) ICS-213 written communication forms

First Aid

- (3) Pre-packed first aid to-go backpacks with first aid supplies, water, etc.
- (1) First aid kit, XXV deluxe
- Additional first aid supplies (bandages, compresses, tape, splints, etc.)
- (50) Triage tags
- Stretcher/backboard



Misc

- (3) 55-gallon potable water containers
 - (3) 8-lb Class A/B/C Fire extinguisher
 - (2) Tarps
 - (4) Sleeping bags
 - (1) Propane adapter hose (for running propane lanterns, stove, etc. from a 20lb BBQ grill propane tank)
 - (1) Coleman propane stove
 - (1) Easel for status board/status sheets
 - (1) Plastic trash can for supply storage
 - (2) Rope, nylon, 1/2", 200 ft
 - (1) Portable gasoline-powered electric generator (1200+ watts), siphon hose, gas container, extension cords, etc. for lighting, recharging batteries, etc.
- MREs, freeze dried/dehydrated food supply
